


977 & 979 Duncan Street Neighborhood Guide



1 Glen Canyon Trailhead Parks and Recreation

The Turquoise Way trailhead is located only a few blocks away, providing convenient access to the entirety of Glen Canyon Park as well as the George Christopher Playground.

2 Glen Canyon Park Parks and Recreation

This 70 acre park located in close proximity to the property features a deep canyon with dramatic geological formations, hiking trails and beautiful views of the surrounding landscape.

3 Christopher Playground Parks and Recreation

A large playground and park directly adjacent to Diamond Heights shopping center which includes a large green space, softball diamonds, tennis and basketball courts and a dog run area.

4 Diamond Heights Village Shopping and Dining

This shopping center is your closest option for grocery shopping or home supplies, and features a Safeway, Walgreens, and a good selection of cafes, restaurants and salons.

5 Douglass Park Parks and Recreation

This nearby park with beautiful city views includes a playground, tennis and basketball courts, as well as a large dog run.

6 Noe Valley Retail Shopping and Dining

All of the amenities you need: banks, coffee shops, Whole Foods, dry cleaners and salons, as well as a large variety of boutiques and fine dining. Our favorites include Firefly, Chocolate Covered and the Noe Valley Farmers Market.

7 Bus Stop Transportation

Located at the intersection of Clipper street and Portola Drive, this is your closest hub for public transit with access to the 48, K, L and L-Owl bus lines.

8 SF School of the Arts Education

An extremely well-regarded public high school with a focus on the arts, excellent academics, and far above average college readiness. Rated 9/10 by Greatschools.org

9 Portola Drive Retail Shopping and Dining

This retail area is another good option for nearby groceries and amenities. It includes a good selection of restaurants, cafes, salons and dry cleaners, as well as a Mollie Stone's and a CVS pharmacy.

10 West Portal Avenue Retail Shopping and Dining

Though slightly farther away, West Portal Avenue is well worth the trip for its diverse assortment of amenities, boutiques, cafes and fine dining. Brava favorites include Little Original Joe's, Orex, Roti, and the Submarine Center.

11 Mount Davidson Parks and Recreation

Hike to the top of this lovely wooded park and take in the views of the downtown skyline, Twin Peaks and Suto Tower from San Francisco's highest peak.

12 Miraloma Elementary Education

This is the attendance area school for 977-979 Duncan. It is a highly-regarded and sought-after public elementary with excellent academics and well above average test scores. Rated 8/10 by Greatschools.org

13 Miraloma Playground Parks and Recreation

This large playground is located next to Miraloma Elementary and includes tennis and basketball courts, a large green space and softball diamond, in addition to city views.

14 Glen Park Rec Center Parks and Recreation

Located at the opposite end of Glen Canyon, Glen Park Recreation Center includes a recently renovated indoor rec center with rock climbing wall, basketball courts, outdoor tennis courts and sports fields, baseball diamonds, and a playground.

15 Walter Haas Playground Parks and Recreation

Boasting breathtaking city views, this playground also features climbing areas, basketball courts, pedestrian trails, a dog park and a large green space ideal for a picnic. Nearby Billy Goat Hill also offers stunning city views.

16 Glen Park Village & BART Shopping and Dining

Charming enclave of high-quality restaurants and shops, as well as access to major BART and Muni lines. Stop at Destination Baking Company for a slice of pie or at Canyon Market for a local produce.
